The Country Club Plaza of Kansas City is known as the first shopping center to accommodate automobiles


in America. A few steps down is the Raphael Hotel, originally built as the Villa Serena Apartments.

The land's history of commerce extends back to its original use as a brickyard/quarry and dairy farm. The Sunset Hills Gardens sat on the property until the Villa Serena Apartments were built.

J.C. Nichols acquires land originally known as Brush Creek Valley. Upon announcing his new

property, the public dubbed it as "Nichols' Folly" since the area was seen as undesirable at that time.

September 12 was one of the most defining

moments in Plaza history. A total of 23 lives

were lost in the flood and Plaza businesses

suffered an estimated \$58 million of damage.

of renovation and revitalization.

Properties in North Carolina, which now runs

The Plaza.


McCanles Building Company purchases three lots for upscale and luxury apartment buildings inspired by the Spanish and

J.C. Nichols purchases the apartments and repurposes the complex into a hotel.




The building is reborn as the Raphael Hotel, with the
